### VILLAGE INSPECTION

Following last summer's successful Village Inspection with Ward Councillors, Parish Councillors and Knowsley Officers, and the subsequent investment and action we saw in the village, we repeated the process on the 15/03/16.

The key issues that we discussed were:

- Continued resurfacing of pavements in Hall Lane and Wheatfield Road.
- Urgent repairs required to the fence and wall barrier between Kenley Ave and Cronton Road
- Schedules and frequency of litter bin emptying.
- Ongoing pothole repair and monitoring.

The Parish Council will continue the communications with both the Ward Councillors and Knowsley Officers.
